A RESOLUTION

APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH JEFFERSON COUNTY OPEN SPACE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BEAR CREEK TRAIL AND GREENBELT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood (the "City") was awarded a \$1,920,000 grant from Jefferson County Open Space ("JCOS") to construct improvements to the Bear Creek Trail and Greenbelt including a soft-surface parallel trail, concrete realignment and repair, bridge replacement, new restrooms, signage and wayfinding (the "Project");

WHEREAS, JCOS has prepared the attached intergovernmental agreement with the City for administration of the grant award (the "IGA");

WHEREAS, the IGA requires from the City \$1,180,000 in matching funds for the Project and that expenditure thereof has been duly authorized; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines entering into the IGA with JCOS and acceptance of the grant award is in the best interest of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

SECTION 1. The IGA is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an IGA on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
